Non-Slip Aluminum Stair Treads Installed at Colter Hall







## THE SITUATION

The history of Northwest College began in 1956 with just one building for all students and administration to use. Today, the College has expanded to 15 academic facilities, 5 resident halls, numerous apartment buildings, and a student center. They offer many academic programs which include transfer degrees, technical degrees, and skills certificates. They have also come a long way from the days of one ping-pong table, as the institution is now home to 7 varsity teams, some of which include men and women's basketball and soccer.

Students, faculty, and visitors main mode of transportation on campus is by foot. Northwest College was looking for a slip-resistant solution for the entrance steps to Colter Hall, which is one of the dorms closest to the academic buildings.

## THE SOLUTION

Exterior steps need protection against outdoor elements, such as weather or frequent foot traffic that cause erosion. Due to its anti-rust, lightweight, and aesthetic properties, the facilities director at NWC and one of the sales representatives at *Slip*NOT® decided aluminum would be the best alloy for the project. The establishment was provided with (12) 3/16" x various sizes x 60" Aluminum 3003 grade 2 stair treads. *Slip*NOT® provided countersunk holes for the treads which were easily retrofitted over the existing concrete steps by bolting.

## THE IMPACT

Northwest College is pleased with the product they received. After installation of the aluminum stair treads, the facilities director contacted SlipNOT® and purchased additional treads for other projects to increase safety on campus.
